PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE ADOPTION OF NEW REGULATION

All citizens are hereby notified that the Secretary of Justice of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico proposes to adopt a new regulation to be known as “**REGLAMENTO PARA ESTABLECER LAS NORMAS QUE REGIRÁN LA PARTICIPACIÓN DEL MINISTERIO PÚBLICO EN LOS ASUNTOS NO CONTENCIOSOS ANTE NOTARIO**”.

This regulation will be adopted pursuant to Article 15 of Act No. 282 of August 21, 1999, as amended, also known as the “Non-Contentious Notarial Matters Act”; Article 18(b) of Act No. 205 of August 9, 2004, also known as the “Organic Act of the Department of Justice”; and Act No. 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, also known as the “Commonwealth of Puerto Rico Uniform Administrative Procedure Act”.

The purpose of the regulation is to establish procedures regarding participation of the Department of Justice in non-contentious notarial matters. The text of the regulation will be available for public inspection in the library of the Department of Justice. The library is located on the ninth floor of the Main Building, 602 Olimpo Street, Miramar, Santurce, Puerto Rico. Business hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. It is also available through the Internet at the following address: www.justicia.gobierno.pr.

Any party interested in submitting comments or requesting a hearing may do so in writing, stating the reasons backing his claim, within thirty (30) days following the publication of this notice.
