

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**REPEAL OF DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE REGULATIONS**

Pursuant to the powers and authority granted by Act No. 38 of June 30, 2017, as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Act of the Government of Puerto Rico," 3 LPRÁ § 9601, et seq., and Act No. 205-2004, known as the "Organic Act of the Department of Justice" (hereinafter Act No. 205), as amended by Reorganization Plan No. 5-2011, known as the "2011 Reorganization Plan of the Department of Justice", the Secretary of the Department of Justice hereby informs of her intention to repeal the following regulations, as registered with the Department of State:
